



NON-RESIDENTIAL TRIPS (UK ONLY)

SOUTHERN ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS ACADEMY IS COMMITTED TO PROVIDING SAFE AND APPROPRIATE NON-RESIDENTIAL TRIP OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN THE UNITED KINGDOM THAT SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCES OF ITS GYMNASTS.

APPROVAL

ALL TRIPS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE ACADEMY DIRECTOR AND COMPLY WITH RELEVANT BRITISH GYMNASTICS GUIDANCE WHERE REQUIRED.

SUPERVISION AND RATIOS

TRIPS MUST OPERATE WITHIN APPROPRIATE SUPERVISION RATIOS OF 1:10 FOR NON-TRAINING ACTIVITIES AND 1:8 FOR TRAINING ACTIVITIES.

TRANSPORTATION

ALL TRAVEL MUST USE PRE-APPROVED TRANSPORTATION METHODS. PLANNED REST BREAKS MUST REMAIN SUPERVISED BY STAFF OR CHAPERONES.

MEDICAL AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

RELEVANT MEDICAL, MEDICATION, ALLERGY, AND EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION MUST BE COLLECTED PRIOR TO TRAVEL. STAFF WILL SEEK APPROPRIATE TREATMENT AND CONTACT PARENTS OR CARERS IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY.

COMMUNICATION

APPROPRIATE COMMUNICATION ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE TRIP, INCLUDING EMERGENCY CONTACT ACCESS FOR STAFF AND GYMNASTS WHERE APPROPRIATE.

RISK ASSESSMENTS AND CONTINGENCY PLANNING

RISK ASSESSMENTS AND CONTINGENCY ARRANGEMENTS MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO TRAVEL AND SHARED WITH RELEVANT STAFF MEMBERS.

DECISION TO TRAVEL

THE DECISION REGARDING A GYMNAST'S SUITABILITY TO TRAVEL RESTS WITH THE ACADEMY DIRECTOR FOLLOWING CONSIDERATION OF INDIVIDUAL NEEDS, WELFARE, BEHAVIOUR, AND SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS.
